


# LITERARY TERM

#### Requirements:

- ❖ You **MUST** include the 4 ✓ terms; the other four are your choice.
  - ❖ Make your journal an individual creation. Include added graphics, doodles, etc. to your journal.
  - ❖ Use correct grammar and spelling in your entries.
- ❖ Keep this log throughout your independent reading and make entries as they are relevant.

## Ideas

### Graphics

Include printed clip art, pictures, or magazine clippings that relate to the literary terms or novel you are discussing.

### Doodle

Create artwork or SYMBOLS to add uniqueness to your journal. Be sure to keep the doodles relevant to the topic being presented.

### Graffiti Text

Put your own spin on the titles and headers of the page. Remember to make sure the text is readable.

### Add Color

Use color to make your journal exciting and fun. Be sure to use only one side of the paper if you think the marker will be distracting on the other side.
